

# Workshop: Data management plans for EU, DFG and BMBF

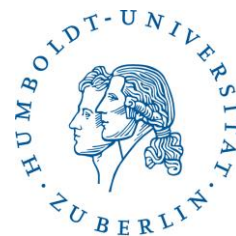
